## Conditions of Sight and Hearing Grants for District V1-4

### Grant applications opened 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2015

- 1; The grant application shall be solely for a program aimed at Sight and or Hearing
- 2; The program shall be run and operated by a Lions Club/s in the District 201 V1-4
- 3; The program can use qualified Sight and Hearing Specialists/Professionals.
- 4; Funding for No3 is acceptable for their time in the project, but not for transportation costs.
- 5; No funding is to be used for hospitality
- 6; Applications are to be sent to the Secretary of the Victorian Lions Foundation (VLF)
- 7; All applications for funding are on a dollar for dollar basis
- 8; All proposed expenditure (budget) is to be submitted prior to the project commencing, no project will be considered if it has commenced.
- 9; All projects to be completed within 6 months
- 10; On completion of the project a Completion Form is to be submitted within 6 weeks, and sent to the Secretary of the VLF.
- 11; Any surplus funds are to be returned to the VLF.
- 12; These rules and conditions may be varied from time to time without notice.
